PLEASE NOTE THAT YOU CAN ONLY DESIGNATE A CHARITY IF YOU ARE DONATING IN INCREMENTS OF \$52 PER CHARITY. IF DONATING LESS THAN \$52, YOUR DONATION WILL BE DISPERSED TO MULTIPLE CHARITIES.
